"Those who will come with full love and faith in our Almighty Kirpal can derive much benefit from this short time, with Master's Grace. Whatever time one spends in the company of a Saint with full Love and Devotion, that is not less than meditation."

Now we should do the business for which we have come here and that is the merchandise of Naam, the work of earning the fruit of Naam. We should from the depth of our heart have the yearning to collect the wealth of Naam as much as possible, and for that we should concentrate more on doing the meditation."
